The Richmond City Health District provides services to prevent the spread of STD's and HIV/AIDS through education, testing, treatment counseling and partner referral services for persons infected. To make an appointment, call the health department call center at 804-205-3501 any time between 8 am and 5 pm Monday through Friday. Appointments are on a first-come first-served basis. There are no walk-in appointment slots available at this time. Continue to check the website for updates.

Resource centers are health clinics that offer STI screening and treatment, along with a variety of other services, available in public housing communities, Broad Rock Community Center, and Southwood Apartments.
