- Vaccine-Preventable Diseases
- Zoonotic Diseases
- Tuberculosis
- Infections Potentially Associated with Healthcare Facilities
- Outbreaks
- Other Reportable and Emerging Diseases

HIV testing and counseling and sexually transmitted disease services are also available. Clinics are available by appointment for medical services (diagnosis and treatment), education, and counseling.
