Behavioral health counselors will meet with the patient to provide information and resources. Behavioral health professionals and psychiatric staff can perform risk assessments for depression, chemical dependence, child or adolescent problems and dementia before determining the most appropriate recommendation for care. A patient can be referred by calling 804-947-3033 or going directly to the Emergency Department at Lynchburg General.
