The Fairfax County Health Department, located at 10777 Main Street in Fairfax, is the administrative office for the county. Its mission is to achieve and maintain optimum personal and community health for its residents by emphasizing health promotion, disease prevention, and environmental protection. Clinic services are provided at the five district offices located in Fairfax, Annandale, Springfield, Alexandria, and Reston. Most services are provided on a sliding fee scale based on income and include:

- Family Planning
- HIV/AIDS Testing
- Immunizations
- Sexually Transmitted Illnesses (STI) Testing and Treatment
- Communicable Disease Control
- Women, Infants & Children (WIC) Nutrition
- Emergency Preparedness & Response
- Environmental Health
- Vital Records--birth and death certificates

Public health staff is available to answer health questions and speak to community organizations, schools, youth groups, and churches. Reference materials, informative pamphlets, and literature can also be obtained at the health department.
