Volunteers of America Chesapeake opens the Cold Weather Shelter; an emergency winter shelter serving up to 18 adults each night from November 15 to March 31 of each year. The program runs from 9 pm until 7 am. Cold Weather Shelter clients receive a hot dinner every night, breakfast in the morning and a bag lunch to take with them. They can also take a shower and wash their laundry. Self-referrals are accepted; Loudoun residents are given preference.

VOA Chesapeake coordinates a variety of on-site services, which includes case management supports, mental health services, and counseling, and resources needed to move from homelessness to housing. All residents are assisted by a case manager who helps them develop an individualized plan that will promote selfsufficient living.

This program is operated under contract with Loudoun County. VOA Chesapeake began operating the program February 2003.
