Outpatient services include, but are not limited to, emergency services, crisis intervention services, diagnosis and evaluation, intake and screening, counseling, psychotherapy, behavior management, psychological testing and assessment, chemotherapy and medication management services, and jail based services.

The Charlotte Clinic offers programs that provide supervised, structured, full-day day time program for individuals who have issues related to substance use, who need treatment that is more intensive than an outpatient program and who do not require 24-hour hospital care.
