Services are provided by interdisciplinary treatment team of psychologists, nursing staff, social workers and activities therapists. All patients receive group treatment services, as well. Family therapy services are provided, as needed.

Options of the program include group psychotherapies, independent living skills training, medication education, stress management, community reintegration and a variety of recreational activities.
