- VALUES therapeutic foster care for custodial and non-custodial children and youth with behavioral and/or emotional problems, or neglect;
- Prevention Services provides the community with basic prevention strategies to enhance protective factors, such as promoting positive mental and emotional well-being and decreasing risk factors such as peer pressure and availability of drugs.;
- Early Childhood Developmental Services provides Early Intervention Services for birth to age 3 with disabilities and/or developmental delay problems.
