Services include Individual & Group Psychotherapy; Marital & Family Counseling; Psychiatric Services; Parenting Classes Intensive In-Home Services; Crisis Services; Medication Monitoring; Case Management; Consultation & Education Services; Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Plan; and Children in the Middle. Also offered at this site are

- Project LINK, an outpatient program for pregnant, substance-abusing women or mothers with dependent children;
- Transitions teaches independent living skills to individuals who are 16 to 21 years old so they may achieve and maintain community stability and independence in the most appropriate least-restrictive environment.
