Grafton offers adult group homes and Integrations, day site, in the Richmond area, serving individuals with complex intellectual and developmental challenges who have aged out of the school system and do not qualify for work programs. Both programs provide a physical space, activities (arts and crafts, music therapy, and physical recreation), and opportunities for individuals to get involved in the community through social, recreation, volunteer, and skill development activities. Our research-based approach to instruction includes informal and formal assessments, curriculum alignment, mapping and data analysis. Grafton serves individuals with mental health challenges, and intellectual and developmental disabilities, as well as those with co-occurring diagnoses. We are also able to serve students with high-functioning Autism.
