Mecklenburg County Health Department participates in the <u>Every Woman's Life</u> program, a public health program sponsored by the Virginia Department of Health that helps uninsured, low income women gain access to the free breast cancer screening services. Clinical breast exams, mammograms and diagnostic tests are performed for enrolled women. Screening and early detection reduce death rates and improve treatment options.

Mammography is an important preventive health procedure for women. For early detection of breast cancer, the best option is regular screening mammograms for women over the age of 40. Screening is also available for women who are 18-39 if they are symptomatic or at high rick for breast cancer.
