At the Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board, the South County Recovery and Drop In Center is a place where people with mental illness can stop by to enjoy a cup of coffee, socialize, or just hang out in a low stress, low demand environment. People who come to the centers connect with (and find hope and inspiration from) a community of people in recovery. Peers encourage one another toward independence in housing, education, and jobs.

The Center serves the Route 1 corridor, the Eleanor Kennedy Shelter residents and other people who are homeless. Laundry, shower, and other resources are available.
