Family-focused services for adolescents include:

- assessment;
- therapy;
- case management services;
- day treatment.

Adult services include:

- psychosocial education;
- individual and group counseling for people with substance use disorders;
- day treatment;
- continuing care services;
- partial hospitalization (daytime for four days per week);
- the community readiness and support program for people with serious mental illness or co-occurring disorders who need help with activities of daily living, social skills training and other aspects of integrating with the community.
