The Arlington County Community Services Board administers the Regional Older Adult Facilities Mental Health Support Team (RAFT). The program is a joint partnership of governments within the region. The RAFT program fills a vital community need for individuals who need assisted living or nursing home level care and are ready to be discharged from a state psychiatric hospital or are at risk of going to a state psychiatric hospital.

The goal of the program is to allow individuals to live in the least restrictive environment possible in a location that is close to home and easily accessible for family and friends. RAFT provides these services:

- Multidisciplinary evaluation,
- Comprehensive plans of care,
- Case management and coordination with physicians and other agencies,
- Regular medication monitoring and evaluation,
- Individual, group and family therapy sessions,

- 24 hour consultation to facilities and mental health training for staff.
