Each site with Behavioral Health Services offers evaluation and treatment services for mood, anxiety and adjustment disorders and the interacting effects of

psychological and behavioral factors and medical conditions. Some examples of this interaction include obesity, smoking cessation, coping with chronic illness, including pain management.

Certain sites offer specialized services for issues such as alcohol and substance abuse, trauma and crisis debriefing, attachment problems, multicultural issues, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder, learning disorders, Autism Spectrum Disorders and neuropsychological evaluation.

Each site with Behavioral Health services also offers coordination of care between behavioral health, medical, and dental providers in order to improve the patient's overall functioning, health status and sense of well-being.
